To Our Valued Grain Suppliers:

I am writing to advise you that on July 8, 2019 (the “**Filing Date**”), ILTA Grain (“**ILTA**” or the “**Company**”) filed for creditor protection under the *Companies’ Creditors Arrangement Act* (“**CCAA**”) with the Supreme Court of British Columbia (the “**Court**”).

The decision to file for CCAA was made after careful consideration and in our view, is a necessary step for the Company to address its financial structure, protect all stakeholders and secure additional financing to fund the continued development of our business.

Current management will lead the restructuring process and continue to operate the business. In addition, the Court has appointed PricewaterhouseCoopers Inc. (“**PwC**”) as monitor (the “**Monitor**”) to provide oversight and supervise the CCAA process. The Monitor will assist ILTA implement a formal plan of arrangement (the “**Plan**”) and generally oversee the CCAA proceedings. The initial order (the “**Initial Order**”) and other relevant materials are posted on PwC’s website at [www.pwc.com/ca/ilta-grain](http://www.pwc.com/ca/ilta-grain).

Consistent with the Initial Order, all balances outstanding prior to the Filing Date are stayed and therefore will not be paid by the Company. We are taking steps to work with the Canadian Grain Commission to protect producers’ rights, realize on their security and to help our suppliers through the claims process to recover these amounts.
